## # 46 HEBREW AAB FORM REDUPLICATE ROOTS

Most Hebrew reduplicate form roots are either of the form ABAB - as in גלגל wheel from base זלזל (round] - זלזל cheapen, deride of base זלזל [flow freely] - or קעקע tattoo of base קעקע [deep] – Or they are of the form ABB - as in כלל [include] of base סבר [all] and as סבב [to surround] of base סבר [around] – However the following specimens are of a more rare and obscure form, namely – the form AAB

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עטף hang down - פט base = hang, drip – [droplets hang before they drip]<sup>1</sup>
ש mouth - פה = mouth
ש star - בוכב base = control, mastery – stars are regarded as controlling luck
ח הותח - טח תח base denotes extend - עותח is a military catapult
ש bastard - from base ביר - strange, estrange
ש bastard - from base ביר - strange ביר - כר base = round – ביר a round area, a loaf – קיקלון
ש disgrace - קלון is disgrace
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לולב Ernest Klein attributes this to לולב [heart]

Possibly derived from קן קיקיון? -

ששר Dye extracted from an insect that remains in its place for months - - ששר denotes continue - שאר = remain

The biblical ממד [a measure, dimension – Job 38:5 ממדיה ] of base ממות ] of base ממות [a death - Jer. 16:4] of base death - and perhaps also ממר [a rebelliousness, irritation – Prov.17:25] perhaps of מר [bitter] all likely belong to this same AAB reduplicate category.<sup>2</sup>
