

#35A - BAIS ב/ YUD י INTER - RELATIONSHIP

A list of Hebrew word pairs demonstrating the fact of a metaphysical conceptual relationship between certain three letter words that possess a ב bais as their middle letter and synonymous words – or conceptually related words - that possess instead a yud י as their middle letter - e.g. זית [olive] and זבת [flowing]

Rabbi Chones [ערוך הקצר] listed a כובסיה [clothes pocket] that might be related to כיס [pocket, pouch]⁸

Note that there is also similar ו / ב interchange phenomenon that I will be detailing in the near future – If G-d will allow

Note also הויה hoyaw that means [there was, he was] And the הב hav base that means [give] which is also the etymon of 'give'. German es gibt [lit. it gives] idiomatically means – there are. Also חיה khayoh means – lives – and Hebrew base חב khov means – obligation . Homiletically speaking the Torah obligates the Jew to do all that he can to stay alive and be in good health⁹

Note also that three letters roots whose format is two consonants with a vav shuruk in between them also yielded a substantial amount of results wherein the vav shuruk became an L or an R sound. E.g. מות morte - גוף corpse - בוץ blotte [mire] - If G-d will allow, I will present a comprehensive list of these transformation specimens in the near future.
